Pinal County Department of Transportation (PCDOT) Adopt a Roadway Program has been in existence since 1988. The Adopt a Roadway Program provides an opportunity for community members and businesses to help keep Pinal Counties roadways litter free. Nearly 23.7 billion pieces of litter are left on 8.3 million miles of roadways in the United States equaling 2,855 pieces per mile. This equates to about 73 littered items per person nationwide. On December 28th, 2021, six of Sycamore Canyon Academy's finest Student Athletes took part in their "Adopted Highway" cleanup. The stretch of cleanup was well over two miles, both back and forth.
