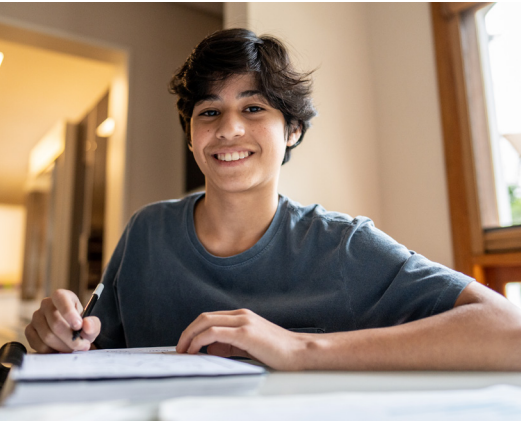


SYCAMORE ACADEMY

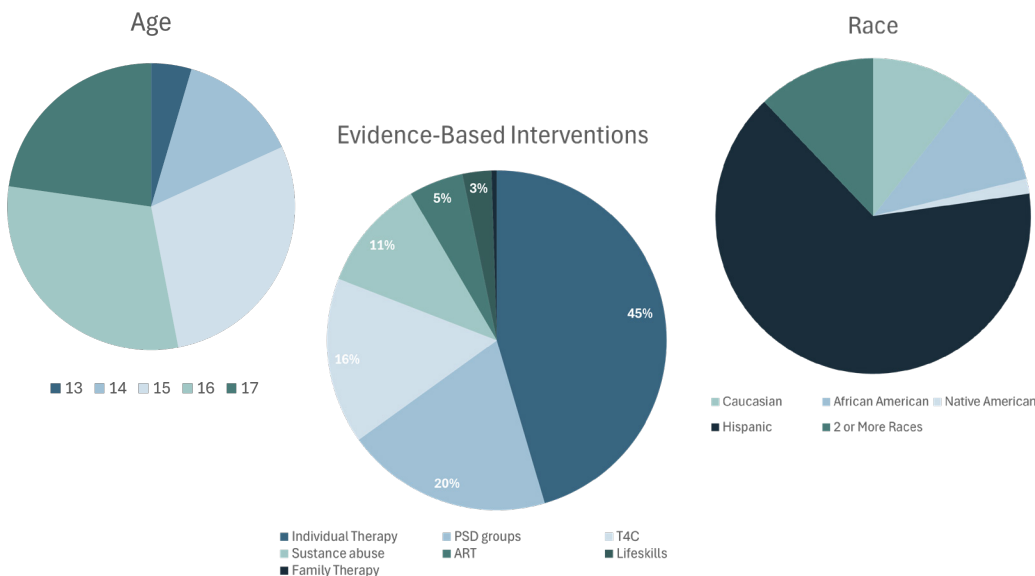
2024 ANNUAL REPORT



Sycamore Canyon Academy is a short-term Intensive Behavior Modification Group Home (IBMGH), licensed by the Arizona Department of Child Safety. The program serves adolescent boys ages 13 to 17, providing a structured and supportive environment focused on behavioral transformation and personal growth.

Residents benefit from a comprehensive range of therapeutic and academic services, designed to meet their individual needs and promote long-term success. The program features a variety of evidence-based interventions, including individual and family therapy, Thinking for a Change (T4C), Aggression Replacement Training (ART), life skills groups, positive skill development, and substance abuse treatment.

2024 OUTCOMES

- 16 years old was the average age in 2024
- 77% of discharges were successful exits
- 6 hours of education per day
- 13 GEDs awarded
- 100% of students received a job skill or vocational certificate
- 581 hours of evidence-based interventions
